## APSAS Scholarship Guidelines

### A. Eligibility for APSAS Scholarship

1. Recipient must have attended Wicomico County Public Schools for a period of at least two (2) years.
2. Recipient must be a resident of Wicomico County during his/her junior and senior years of high school.
3. Recipient must be a graduating senior of a Wicomico County high school.
4. Recipient must have a G.P.A of 3.0 or higher.

### B. Conditions of APSAS Scholarship

1. The recipient may attend a college, university or technical school of his/her choice.
2. The scholarship shall be paid directly to the recipient.

### C. Student nomination form

1. To be completed by the student
2. To be verified by the school counselor
3. Must contain
  - a. student resume
  - b. transcripts
  - c. 2 letters of reference

### D. Selection of nominees

1. This scholarship will be available for four students (one from each county high school).
2. Maximum benefit will be \$500 per student.
3. All applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee.
4. Selection will be made on or before May 1.
