Maryland DAR Scholarship Information

The Maryland State Society Daughters of the American Revolution (MSSDAR) awards \$500 scholarships to graduating high school seniors who are Maryland residents. Applicants must be citizens of the United States and plan to attend an accredited college or university in the United States, pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's degree. Scholarships are renewable for up to an additional 3 years upon annual review and approval of an official college transcript by the State Chairman. It is expected that students maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Each student should complete the application, gather additional required documentation, and submit everything to his or her sponsoring MSSDAR Chapter Scholarship Chairman, or Chapter Regent, no later than **JANUARY 15**. For chapters, the application is located on the MSSDAR member's website.

The sponsoring Chapter then reviews the forms for completeness, talks with student if possible, writes a letter of recommendation, signs the application, and submits the package to the State Chairman postmarked no later than **JANUARY 31**.

Only complete applications submitted in one package on time from the Chapter will be considered. Packages are not returned to the Chapter or the student. Chapters may sponsor more than one student.

Scholarships are awarded without regard to age, race, religion, sex, or national origin. Awards are based on academic excellence and financial need. Neither applicants nor their families need be members of DAR, SAR or C.A.R.

Winners and their sponsoring chapters will be notified by the State Chairman in February. Winners will be invited to accept their award, and sponsoring chapters will be recognized, at the Maryland State Conference in March. Scholarships are sent to the college by the State Treasurer in late July or early August. Any unused portion of the award must be returned.
