Scholarship Award Guidelines



A. Choice of School:

West Virginia University, Morgantown, West Virginia

B. Who May Apply:

Applicants must be current 12th grade students of Parkside High School in Wicomico County, Maryland who have applied and plan on attending West Virginia University in Morgantown, West Virginia.

C. Considerations:

Applicants must have at least a 3.0 weighted GPA. Applicants must have a reputation of good character, be a well-rounded citizen and have participated in extra-curricular school or community activities. Successful applicants should demonstrate they have the maturity and commitment to succeed in college level courses of study.

D. Nature of Award: \$1,000 for one academic year.

E. How to Apply:

Applications are available on the www.cfes.org website or the Parkside High School guidance office. Completed applications must be submitted to the Parkside High School Guidance Office by no later than April 15th to be considered for a scholarship award, only when the following have been submitted:

1. A completed scholarship application.
2. Official high school transcript of grades.
3. Letter of acceptance from West Virginia University.
4. Essay – Who in your life has been your biggest influence and why?
5. Three letters of recommendation from non-family members
 - two from teachers
 - one from a non- family member of the community
(e.g. guidance counselor, employer, athletic coach, etc.)
6. Applicant may be required to be interviewed by the Scholarship Advisory Committee.
