SCHOLARSHIP AWARD GUIDELINES**

- A. Choice of School: Accredited four-year college or university, or accredited two-year institution
- B. Who May Apply: Applicants must be graduating seniors who are currently enrolled in a Wicomico County school and have been accepted for enrollment at an accredited four-year college or university, or accredited two-year institution.
- C. Qualifications: Applicants must be graduating seniors from a Wicomico County high school and have met the following two criteria:
(1) completed two hundred twenty-five (225) hours of community service; and
(2) have maintained a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- D. Nature of Award: Up to \$500.00 for one academic year
- E. Criteria: The following criteria shall be used by the Scholarship Committee in selecting scholarship recipients:
- Community service
 - Propensity or interest in the law as a career
 - Involvement in law-related activities (i.e. mock trial)
 - Academic merit
 - Overall quality of the application essay
 - Geographical representation throughout the county
